Call To Order: Mayor Moore called the special called council meeting to order on June 8, 2023 at 6:30pm.

Invocation: Mayor Moore

Approval of Agenda: Commissioner Wheeler made a motion to approve the agenda. Mayor Pro Tem Atkinson seconded the motion. Vote was passed unanimously.

Presentations/Discussions:

- a. Commissioner Wheeler wants something (a display case or frames) for the sports memorabilia that he is collecting. The Board chose to add \$1,500 to the budget for this project.
- b. Commissioner Mercer mentioned that postage is going up July 1st.
- c. The budget proposal was reviewed and these items were addressed:
 - Commissioner Wheeler thinks that the amount for the auditor should come down when we get things back on track.
 - Mayor Moore plans to meet with Sheriff Woodard to negotiate the upcoming contract and try to get that amount reduced.

- We will have the Public Works dept. to deep clean the depot instead of hiring a company to do so.
- Financial Officer Owens stepped in and explained what "other expenses not used" meant on the budget proposal.
- Carolina Pump and Sewer will be increasing their contract by \$250, but this will include mowing grass around specified areas.
- Commissioner Wheeler wants the Public Works dept. to pick up limbs from senior citizen's yards as a courtesy. The senior citizen would need to call the office and request this.
- d. It was mentioned that the Public Works dept. and Zoning Officer Lucas are doing a good job.
- e. Mayor Moore is wanting to approve the budget at the June 13th regular council meeting.
